ENTRIES CLOSE ON May 22, 2024, at 6 PM MT and must be received by that date/time at the trial secretary's address, after which time entries cannot be canceled, altered, or substituted except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows. Envelopes/transactions containing entries for more than the ten (10) dog maximum and/or entries received prior to the opening date shall be treated as an invalid entry and shall be returned to the sender. Express mail entries must include the signature waiver allowing them to be left at the secretary's address. No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry and the Trial Secretary will add a \$50.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

PRELIMINARY RUNNING ORDER / BRIEFING / DAY OF TRIAL ENTRIES

Preliminary Running Order: Competitors will be assigned a half-hour block for their runs. The club will attempt to get competitors with multiple dogs into the same time block.

Competitors will be assigned to a time block when they are sent their initial email confirmation. If the competitor needs a different time block, please reply to the email. We will try to accommodate time block requests but cannot guarantee them.

Dogs may run both fetch runs back to back, or they may have a couple of dogs in between runs. The final running order will be sent out after closing. There will be 5 runs per ½ hour block per judge.

General Briefing: There will be a general briefing for every time block.

Day Of Entries: Day Of Entries will be accepted if the trial does not fill. Because of limited parking at the venue, the time the secretary will take Day Of entries will be announced after closing and a couple of days before the trial itself. Please contact the secretary if you want to enter Day Of for the best time to arrive and to ask how many runs will be available. Day Of Entries will most likely not be accepted before noon on the trial date, June 1, 2024.

Move-up deadline is Thursday, May 30, 2024, at 5:00 pm. Please email the trial secretary at secretary@pawtap.net to request a move-up. If a dog titles on their first run (already having a novice leg from a prior trial) move-ups will be allowed for the second run.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs SIX (6) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), or an AKC Canine Partners listing number. Approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate. Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Dogs with physical challenges (including amputees) are eligible to participate provided that, in the opinion of the judge, the dog displays no sign of physical discomfort and can safely complete the fetch. Deaf and blind dogs are allowed to enter. Aggressive dogs or dogs suffering from an injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance may not participate. No dog shall compete if it is sutured, bandaged, or has any visible wounds.

Bitches in season are allowed to participate in this AKC Fetch test. If your bitch comes into season before or during the trial, please notify the trial chair as soon as you know. Bitches in season are required to run at the end of the day after all runs have been completed. (AKC Fetch Rules Part 1 Page 6.)

WAIT LIST / SUBSTITUTIONS

Wait List: The Bristle Nose Scent Work Club of Utah is offering a wait list to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing date. All pre-entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the trial secretary prior to the closing date (as listed on the first page of this premium) at the trial secretary's address. No entries may be withdrawn for a refund after the closing date unless the withdrawn entry is replaced by a waitlisted entry.

Substitutions: Substitutions will be allowed on a limited basis. If an entered dog has a behavioral issue or medical emergency, the owner may substitute another dog into those runs.

CRATING

Crating will be in competitors' cars. Please be prepared for any type of weather. In June in Utah, there can be freezing snow or melting heat.

A **Dog-relief Area** will be described during check-in and the handler briefing. Handlers should limit where their dog(s) relieve themselves to this area. Dogs should not relieve themselves on any man-made structure or anything likely to be touched by people.

AREA INFORMATION

All Fetch runs will be outdoors on grass. The trial site is a private home and yard. Please be respectful of the entire property at all times. It is not appropriate to scout the trial location prior to the trial date. Parking at this location is limited so please come for your time block and then release your parking space after all your runs are completed. Please clean up after your dogs and do not let male dogs lift their legs on anything that people will pick up.

EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR, and LIABILITY

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such cases, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all fetches safely. The Bristle Nose Scent Work Club of Utah (BNSWCU) and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assume no responsibility for injury to children. BNSWCU reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the Bristle Nose Scent Work Club of Utah or any official thereof.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendations to ensure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, and any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

Collars, Leashes, and Harnesses. Dogs may wear slip collars, buckle collars, and Martingales in the AKC Fetch test. They may not wear prong collars, e-collars, head collars, muzzles, or body harnesses. Leashes should be 4 ft. to 6 ft. long and should be made of fabric, leather, or biothane. All dogs must be on leash at all times except when performing their Fetch runs. Retractable leashes may not be used when on trial grounds. Dogs must enter and exit the fetch area with the leash attached to the collar or harness, including when waiting in the area before and after the fetch run.

Trial Site. The trial site is a private home and yard. Please be respectful of the entire property at all times. It is not appropriate to scout the trial location prior to the trial date.

Spectators. Handlers may have anyone watch and video their runs. Please stay an appropriate distance from the fetch field.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without the benefit of a refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the trial grounds.

Assisting: No one outside the fetch area may assist the handler in any way.

REFUNDS

If you are feeling ill and think you may have contracted COVID-19, your entry fees will be refunded, minus the \$3.50 AKC processing fee. You must notify the secretary no later than the night before to receive a refund. In all other cases, no entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee. Dogs pulled after closing because of injury or other medical conditions are not eligible for a refund.

RINGSIDE

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at the fetch area when it is to be judged. The club has no responsibility to provide service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

VENDORS

There will be no food or beverages for sale on the trial grounds. There are restaurants within a short driving distance of the venue. Commercial sales may be allowed on the show grounds during the weekend. Please contact the trial committee for more information.

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim of loss, injury or damage to this dog.
