READ CAREFULLY! THESE RULES WILL BE ENFORCED!

We are experiencing a very difficult time in our lives with the novel coronavirus pandemic sweeping through the world. We are confident that following these rules will allow us to have a safe and fun experience during this Scent Work trial. Please take these into consideration before you enter. If you cannot follow these rules you will be asked to leave the show grounds and your entry fees WILL NOT be refunded.

1. **Masks Are Required!** - You will not be allowed on the show grounds unless you wear a mask. You will not be allowed to run your dog unless you wear a mask. Please make sure your dogs are accustomed to you, and others, wearing masks. This can be strange for some dogs.
2. Keep a physical distance of at least 6 feet (2 meters) from all other people at all times.
3. Ribbons will be self-serve. Please give each other room and keep apart when getting ribbons.
4. Hand Sanitizer will be provided by the club. However, you are encouraged to bring your own.
5. Since the running order will be self-queueing, and handlers are required to maintain 6 feet distance, a table will be provided near the start of each element/level. You will drop your sheet off on the table, and the gate steward will then step in once you have left it. Please **DO NOT** get close to the gate steward when dropping off your sheet. Please **DO NOT** hand your score sheet to the judge or any steward.
6. If a judge is unable to come to the trial, or if we lose a location, entry fees for that judge/element/location will be refunded.

Trial 1 both days: Check-in will be open from 7:30 am to 11:00 am.
Trial 2 both days: Check-in will start 30 minutes after the conclusion of Trial 1.

When you check in, you will be handed your score sheets for the elements you are entered in. You will then be responsible to hold onto that score sheet until it is your time to run.

You will drop your score sheet off on the table provided near the entry of your search area. The gate steward will then step in once you have left it. Please DO NOT get close to the gate steward when dropping off your sheet. Please DO NOT hand your score sheet to the judge or any steward. The gate steward will be responsible for keeping the score sheets in order. PLEASE BE PATIENT with the gate steward. If you do not run in the exact order you think you should, be kind to your other competitors and let another dog/handler team run.

You will be responsible to check in for your searches!

If you arrive after your level & element are complete, you will not be allowed to run. We will not reset up areas for late handlers.

Conflicts will be handled on an individual basis. If your dog(s) are entered in elements which are running at the same time, please inform the gate steward. Sticky notes will be provided if necessary. If you are on time and have a conflict, the ring

will be held for you so you can get all your searches in.

In order to facilitate a smoothly running trial with physical distancing, we will be using a group texting app called Remind. This is a free texting application which will allow our gate stewards and trial chair to send out texts to handlers to inform them when their search element will start. We also may use this to text which dogs are on the line, on deck, and in the hold. We will have one channel for each of our trials. This means we will have 4 channels for the weekend.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs SIX (6) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate. Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Dogs with physical challenges (including amputees) are eligible to participate provided that, in the opinion of the judge, the dog displays no sign of physical discomfort and can safely complete the search. Deaf and blind dogs are allowed to enter. Females in season may not participate, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from an injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental

performance may not participate. No dog shall compete if it is sutured, bandaged, or has any visible wounds.

WAIT LIST INFORMATION

The Bristle Nose Scent Work Club of Utah is offering a wait list to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing date/time. A maximum of 25 entries per day will be placed on the club's wait list. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to September 4, 2019 at 5 PM. No entries may be withdrawn with a refund after closing date. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial will receive a full refund.

CRATING, STAGING AREA, HANDLER'S BRIEFING, AND WARM-UPS

Dogs will need to be crated in vehicles. Crating space will be limited or non-existent. Parking areas are limited, more information will be provided in the final email confirmation.

The **Staging Area** will be out of view of search area(s). The Staging Area will include a warm-up and waiting area, as well as the secretary table for check-ins and posting of running order and results. Due to COVID19, please do not approach the secretary table any closer than 6 feet.

The **Handler's Briefing** will take place in view of the search area prior to the start of each class, after the hide(s) have been set and after the Demo Dog has run. In the Handler's Briefing, the judge will explain if there's an off-leash option, number of hides, maximum height of hides and maximum time for the search. NO DOGS are to be present during the Handler's Briefing.

A **Warm-up Area** will be available consisting of ONE marked container of each odor being tested at the trial and may also consist of blanks containers. Exhibitors should limit their warm-up to (2) two minutes or less. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the handler-dog team prior to their run, or for recovery after the run. The warm-up area is not for training or relieving of the dog.

A **Dog-relief Area** will be available and described during check-in and the handler briefing. Handlers should limit where their dog/s relieve themselves to this area. A dog should not relieve themselves on anything man-made or likely to be touched by people.

SEARCH AREA INFORMATION

Search areas may be of any shape, and of the size specified in the Regulations for each class. All searches will be outdoors and could be on grass, gravel, earth, concrete, or asphalt surfaces. Walk throughs will be provided before each element so handlers will be able to see the search areas.

Search areas, potty areas, and walking paths might include uneven ground and/or 1-3 steps or changes in elevation, and might be located a distance from the competitor waiting area.

Search Area Sizes will be in compliance with AKC Scent Work standards.

EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly

engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all searches safely. The Bristle Nose Scent Work Club of Utah (BNSWCU) and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. BNSWCU reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the Bristle Nose Scent Work Club of Utah or any official thereof.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. If you

Collars, Leashes and Harnesses. During searches, dogs must wear a properly fitted collar or harness approved by the judge. A wearable camera such as a Go Pro may be mounted to the dog's harness, if desired. Leashes may be of any length and/or retractable. The leash should be made of plain, pliable material. All dogs must be on leash at all times, and retractable leashes may not be used when on trial grounds (except during judged searches). Dogs must enter and exit the search area with the leash attached to the collar or harness, including when waiting in the search area before and after the search. An off-leash option may be offered at the discretion of the judge, only if the area is completely enclosed.

Trial Site. It is not appropriate to scout the trial location prior to the trial date. Many search locations are real-life environments and such visits may risk the host losing the opportunity to use the location in the future.

Possession of Odors and Training. Chapter 5. Section 26 of the Scent Work Regulations state "No person other than those engaged in the administration of a trial shall be in possession of any target odor when on the trial grounds. There shall be no training on the grounds of the AKC Scent Work trial, other than the designated warm-up area".

Spectator Area. Spectators are encouraged. Any person not handling a dog in the current class, or any person who has already completed their run in the class may choose to watch the search from the spectator area. Handlers may not watch other exhibitors from their class prior to their run except in the case of Handler Discrimination classes. No one outside the search area may assist the handler or disclose the location of the hide. Spectators who intentionally or unintentionally give aid to a team may be ask to leave the area by the judge. Spectators are forbidden to discuss details of the search until the completion of the class.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds.

Videoing of runs will be allowed. However, if you are found to upload videos of your search to social media before your element/level is complete any qualifying score you received for that run could be revoked.

REFUNDS

If you are feeling ill and think you may have contracted COVID19, your entry fees will be refunded, minus the \$3.50 AKC processing fee. You must notify the secretary no later than the night before to receive a refund. In all other cases: no entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be

refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee. Dogs pulled after closing because of injury or other medical condition are not eligible for a refund. Bitches in season will be refunded entry fees less the AKC processing fee. Notification in writing must be given to the trial secretary no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class of the day of the trial.

RINGSIDE

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at the search area when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility to provide service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

Exhibitors MUST check-in EACH day they are entered.

Claims will be arbitrated as set forth on the official AKC Entry Form for this event.

VENDORS

There will be no food or beverages for sale on the trial grounds. No professional photographer will be available for photography services. No commercial sales will be allowed on the show grounds during the weekend.

Novice B classes is open all dogs. Dogs may enter multiple dogs in different levels within each element (with the exception of Handler Discrimination), at each trial. Multiple dogs from the same owner may be entered in the same class/level, provided they are run by different handlers. Dogs entering the Advanced, Excellent, Master or Detective classes must have earned the required title, as stipulated in the AKC Scent Work Regulations. To be eligible for the High in Trial award you must be entered in all elements (Interior, Exterior, Buried, and Containers), in the same class, for that trial.
